House Bill 4545 Section


HB 4545 establishes new requirements for accelerated instruction for students who do not pass the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR®). It states that any student who did not achieve at least 'Approaches' in any subject assessed (or did not test for that subject) must receive accelerated instruction. At a high level, the legislation includes:

- Elimination of grade retention and retesting requirements in grades 5 and 8
- For any student who does not pass the STAAR test in grade 3, 5, or 8 in math or reading, a new LEA requirement to establish an accelerated learning committee to develop an individual educational plan for the student and monitor progress
- Any student 3-8 who did not achieve at least approaches must receive accelerated instruction.

Aligned with Education Galaxy and Liftoff, HB 4545 is designed to identify students who are behind grade level in specific subjects and give them the focused instruction and support to meet or surpass grade-level standards in a relatively short period of time.


Liftoff Adaptive Intervention




Drop Down a Grade Level
